There is clearly a significant local interest in these proposed sites and the Gildersome Parish Council encourages local residents to comment on specific sites or the general policies during this "Issues and Options" stage.

We have drafted a letter templates which people are welcome to use or adapt to assist their responses to Leeds City Council.

Please comment upon the sites which specifically concern you and bring your local knowledge to indicate the reasons why this specific site is unsuitable for housing development. We have added separate paragraphs making brief comments on each to assist. Please pick and choose which ones you would like to include in your letter.

Remember: clearly state your reasons for objecting and demonstrate the impact of the development on you and your community. It is crucial to be specific, factual, concise, and focus on valid planning considerations.

N.B. The most important thing is to express your views on the proposals. Do not wait . Have your say now.
